


Instructions


- Before commencing work, isolate the mains power supply and remove the fuse in the fuse box or switch off the circuit breaker in the consumer unit.
- Pass cable through the entry holes / glands in mounting (back) box and connect as per the relevant diagram below. Check that the wires are adequately clamped in the socket by giving them a pull test.
- Should an Earth loop connection be required, use the earth terminal block in the back box. All Earth connections must be made and maintained.
- When installation is correctly completed, re-connect mains supply.

discolouration of the metal face plate due to moisture in your wall after fresh wallpaper / plastering

Maintenance - To help maintain the original finish of this product, wipe a soft cloth over the face plate periodically
